Rules and regulations

1. The subject of framing rules and regulations by the Commission was taken up for discussion.
2. The Commission noted the regulations framed by the CIC. It was decided to compare these regulations with those framed by other quasi-judicial bodies like KERC, Karnataka Appellate Tribunal and Karnataka Administrative Tribunal. The regulations for KIC may be drafted by the Secretary and put up in the next meeting for approval of the Commission.

Staffing pattern

3. Prevailing staffing pattern in the Commission was analyzed. Due to increasing work load and for the smooth running of benches of the Commission, it was proposed that the following posts be created and a detailed proposal with justifications be sent to Government for approval:

a) PS (Grade- 2) to SCIC	1 Post
b) Judgment Writers	3 Posts
c) Stenographers	2 Posts
d) Assistants/Data Entry Operators	2 Posts
e) Junior Assistants	2 Posts
f) Group 'D'	4 posts

4. In all, Commission accorded approval for creation of 14 posts.

Finalizing the replies to Audit Report


5. After detailed discussions, it was decided to write to Government to accord post facto approval for carrying forward the unspent balance during 2006-07 and 2007-08.

Uploading the orders of the Commission


